Players will participate in regular training and weekend competition, with teams, age groups and competition formats determined by registrations and Gold Coast Baseball Association (GCBA).

Please note: Baseball uses an official Age Matrix to determine eligibility. The age bands above describe the relevant pathway and are not a substitute for the official matrix. Players may be eligible to play in an older division where permitted by competition rules.

Registration / Sign-On Information

All players—new and returning—must complete registration for the 2026/2027 Summer Season.

Registration includes:

- Player registration with the relevant baseball association
- Mudgeeraba Baseball Club membership
- Insurance and competition registration
- Eligibility to participate in training and games
- Access to club communication through Spond

Registration fees are completed in 2 parts.

1. **GameDay Registration (Capitation fees) [Register/Renew Now](#) ; and**
2. **Mudgeeraba Baseball Club Fee (invoiced separately by the Club).**

Capitation fees are mandatory fees set by Baseball Queensland and Baseball Australia. They cover national and state insurance governance, administration etc. Players must pay these compulsory fees **BEFORE** taking the field. These fees are separate from Mudgeeraba Baseball Club fees which are set by our club and cover local operational costs for the season.

Additional costs may apply for uniforms, equipment, representative baseball or other optional activities.

Play On Vouchers

Mudgeeraba Baseball Club accepts **Play On Queensland vouchers** towards club registration fees. Vouchers can be used to pay the **Mudgeeraba Baseball Club component of the fees** for the 2026/2027 Summer Season. If you have a Play On voucher, please advise the treasurer when you receive your club invoice.

You're very welcome! Mudgeeraba Baseball Club welcomes players of all experience levels. Your child does not need previous baseball experience to join. Keep an eye out for our Come & Try sessions to find out more.

Training

Training is an important part of developing skills, confidence and teamwork. Training days and times will be confirmed by individual team coaches once teams have been formed.

- Arrive ready to participate at the scheduled start time
- Wear appropriate sports clothing and footwear
- Bring a water bottle
- Bring a baseball glove and required equipment
- Be ready to listen, learn and have fun

Please let your coach know through Spond if your child is unable to attend training or a game.



Spond – Our Club Communication App

Spond is the primary communication platform for Mudgeeraba Baseball Club.

All summer season families are asked to download the Spond App and create a profile. Once your profile has been created, request to join the Mudgeeraba Baseball Club master group. Families will be allocated to teams once team lists are finalised.

What Do I Need?

New players don't need to purchase everything before they start. Players will generally need:

- Baseball glove (loans are available from the club)
- Appropriate sports shoes
- Water bottle
- Club uniform
- Appropriate protective equipment as required for their age/division

Your coach or team manager will provide information about any specific equipment required for your age group. If you're unsure what to purchase, please ask before buying—we are happy to help.

Uniforms

Mudgeeraba junior players wear Red Shirts, White pants, Red Socks, Navy Belt and a Club Cap

Red playing shirts are loaned to players at the start of each season. Looking after these shirts mean that we can continue to loan out shirts for future season.

Players are provided with 1 baseball cap per season with priority given to new players.

1 training shirt will be provided per player per season. These shirts are to be worn to training and club activities.
