Batting Cage Rules & Cleanliness Guidelines

To ensure a safe, respectful, and clean environment for all members, please follow the rules below when using the batting cages.

BATTING CAGE RULES

1. Supervision Required

Children under 16 must be supervised by a coach or responsible adult at all times.

2. Batting Helmets Must Be Worn

Helmets are mandatory for all hitters inside the cage.

3. One Batter at a Time

Only one person may be in the batter's box while hitting. All others must stay behind the protective netting.

4. No Horseplay

Running, climbing on nets, or rough behaviour is strictly prohibited.

5. Use Proper Equipment

Only baseball or softball gear is permitted. No cricket bats, golf clubs, etc.

6. Pitching Machines

Only trained personnel may operate pitching machines. Turn off when not in use.

7. Time Limits May Apply

Be courteous and allow others to use the cage. Teams may be asked to rotate during busy times.

8. Respect Coaches and Volunteers

Follow instructions from Mudgeeraba Baseball Club staff and coaches at all times.

9. Cage Code For Club Members Only

Our cages are locked and a code is given to Club members only. It will be changed on a regular basis so reach out to Committee for the new one.

The code must never be given out to a non Club member.

CLEANLINESS GUIDELINES

1. No Food or Drink Inside the Cages

Keep all food and beverages outside the netted area. Water bottles only.

2. Pick Up After Yourself

Remove all gear, balls, and rubbish when you finish.

3. Return Equipment

Return tees, balls, L-screens, and any other shared items to their proper place.

4. Report Damage

If you notice any broken equipment or damage to the cage, report it to a coach or club official immediately.

5. Keep It Clean for the Next Team

Leave the area better than you found it — ready for the next team or player.
